

KAMRISDALEN



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Kamrisdalen is a fracture zone, where two blocks of the rock have moved in different directions. This is usually also called rejection. The cleft in the rock has vertical walls about 20 meters deep and is about 15 meters wide. Geoscientifically interesting object, and an interesting excursion destination. Well worth a visit! Easy hike of just under 1 km.





Directions from Bräcke

Follow road 323 from Bräcke towards Nyhem. After 5 km, turn off towards Öratjärndalen. After about 3 km you will reach a sign showing the way. Follow the path for about 1 km.
